## EXAMINATION INFORMATION

The Department of Mathematical Sciences allows students to receive credit in certain mathematics courses upon passing an examination administered by the department. Courses for which students may receive credit by examination are:

MATH 00100	Introduction to Algebra
MATH 11000	Fundamentals of Algebra
MATH 11100	Algebra
MATH M118	Finite Mathematics
MATH M119	Brief Survey of Calculus
MATH 15300	College Algebra & Trigonometry I
MATH 15400	College Algebra & Trigonometry II
MATH 15900	Precalculus (Algebra & Trigonometry I & II)
MATH 16500	Analytic Geometry & Calculus I
MATH 16600	Analytic Geometry & Calculus II
MATH 22100	Calculus for Technology I
MATH 22200	Calculus for Technology II

### IMPORTANT:

- Prior to registering for this exam, students should review course materials for the course they plan to receive credit for or test out of. Course documents may be found at [www.math.iupui.edu/courses](http://www.math.iupui.edu/courses) by selecting the course number. Final exams and practice problems may be used to review. Math textbooks are kept on reserve at the University Library Reference Desk.
- There is no fee for taking an examination; however, students passing an examination may have to pay the University a fee for granting credit (see <http://registrar.iupui.edu/speccred.html>).
- Students wishing to take any examination must register to do so in the Math Office, LD 270, by submitting a completed Registration Form (front page). **Students must not have received a grade other than a W in the course if taking for credit.**
- An **official Photo ID** (ex. JagTag, Drivers' License) is **required** at time of test. **No** test will be administered without proper identification.
- Students must bring #2 pencils with which to take the exam.
- **The only calculator that can be used on exams numbered 15900 and below is a TI-30XA.** *No calculators will be allowed on exams numbered 16500 or higher.* The Department does have several TI-30XAs available for testing use on a first-come, first-serve basis.
- Students will receive an email sent to their official university email account with the result of their exam, *approximately two business days* after the exam has been administered.
- **Grades will NOT be given over the phone.**
- Upon passing the exam, the Math Department will forward the necessary paperwork to the Registrar's office (if credit by exam), and special credit will be awarded on the student's transcript.
- If you do not wish to receive credit for this exam, please check "Proficiency" at the top of the front page.
- This **exam can only be taken once per course.**
